

If you are a fan of, or have ever read, *The Catcher in the Rye* by JD Salinger, then you may be interested in discovering what old JD has been up to since his passing into the Afterlife in 2010. This may seem misguided or even insane to some people...



So, you get the picture that if you really wanted to contact someone on the other side as Joanne did, you could start by simply writing a letter! Of course this might not work if you weren't already an excellent medium and channeler.



Hildegard Von Bingen

Bad-Ass Defender of the Divine Feminine

Hildegard Von Bingen, Benedictine nun, abbess, saint and Doctor of the Catholic church was one of the most fascinating, prim, yet bad-ass women who has ever lived. She was that rare combination of a balanced divine

feminine and sacred masculine—the two primal energies which we all have coursing through our energetic bodies. She was at once disciplined, virtuous and supremely committed to upholding the welfare of her community and equally committed to tearing down that which she thought was unproductive or damaging to the people and principles she loved. She was a true prophet, seer, artist, poet, musical composer, scientist and consummate lover of nature.

Hildegard was born in Bingen, Germany and lived near the Rhine River during the high middle ages, a time rich with mystical imagination, European expansion and economic growth. Also known as "the golden age of monasticism," Hildegard enjoyed the

privilege of studying and teaching an extensive variety of subjects during her lifetime from visionary theology to medicinal and scientific writings. Hildegard began having visions when she was three years old, which continued throughout her life. With the help of her long-time associate and scribe Volmar, they produced a treasury of illuminated volumes documenting her visions as well

as diagnosis, prognosis, and treatments of physical diseases which were treated with holistic methods centered on "spiritual healing." She became well known for her healing powers involving the practical application of tinctures, herbs, and

precious stones. She has also been considered by many in Europe to be the founder of scientific natural history in Germany. She lived by the axiom: *All things put on Mother earth are for the use of humans*. In other words, her view of Mother earth and the divine feminine was that of provider, nurturer, healer and protector.

Perhaps her boldest accomplishments are associated with a consistent call for the emergence of the Divine Feminine to balance the patriarchal powers in her day. In Hildegard's visionary theology, she unflinchingly refers to Jesus himself as an

aspect of the Divine Feminine. With that in mind she had no problem standing up to, and in many cases, chastising the powerful people in her day including abbots, bishops, statesmen, emperors and even popes. Hildegard called on this nurturing "mother-power" to provide the soul-force she needed to move out of fear and into a life of nonviolent, loving warrior hood. One may think of her as the "Oprah of her day," for her power and influence was known throughout Europe and to this day she is still revered throughout the world.

Hildegard clearly saw a beautiful order and wisdom throughout creation and she sought to understand it with all of her heart and mind. She believed God desires an intimate, nurturing relationship with

creation, far from being distant or aloof, she believed Spirit longs for us, hurts when we hurt, delights in our joys, disciplines our errors, and opens her loving arms to embrace us when we fail. In other words, she believed the Divine feminine is the aspect of God which offers unconditional love and a sense of cosmic belonging.

Hildegard Von Bingen is one of the best-known composers of sacred monophony, and is thought to be "the mother of opera" after composing and performing Ordo virtutum, a sung morality play about the battle between human virtue and the temptation. Her music has been performed throughout the world and continues to be reinterpreted by individuals such as Hildegard Von Blingin' and Richard Souther's electronic mix titled: Vision—The Music of Hildegard von Bingen, which won the Billboard Classical/ Crossover album of the year award in 1994.

You could easily say Hildegard was a supreme mother herself as, throughout her lifetime, she birthed countless original creations dedicated to and in praise of the Divine Feminine. She knows and doesn't care that the social majority, always suspicious of individuality, must reinforce the flow of the status quo, labeling her unappealing or unwanted. There is a confidence that comes from being your true self, that no one or any rulebook can take away.

ENW manifest personal style that's impossible to categorize, creating identity from the inside out. These curious adventuresses are young at heart, playful, but not play things. Their great compassion extends from intelligence. A respectful manner in dealing with people, animals, and valued things, exemplifies their regard. This sensitive, idealistic nature will not be found among the rough and tumble, an Eccentric Nerd Woman's scene is more meditative. A career would have to challenge mind, body or spirit. Naturally committed to purpose and outcome, these are the women you want on any team.

Eccentric Nerd mares are also hard to catch. When randy, biologically programmed stallions pursue fertile mares they take the ones easily lassoed, but not always the finest. perpetual contentment. She will be a friend, confidant, and an equal; easy to love but impossible to control. And never, ever a desperate housewife.



It is no less powerful for us in our own modern times, but we have virtually no terminology for it" ~ until now.



Children watch and copy behavior. They learn what reactions they can get.

Children listen and repeat what they hear. They experiment and discover ways of connecting, belonging and learning to relate to their world.

Children have feelings they can't put into words. They feel sensations inside their young bodies: tingling, heaviness, rushing, pounding, buzzing, etc. Their minds, bodies and nervous systems can feel overwhelmed with sensorial stimulation which can be confusing, upsetting, scary, and even nauseating.

Adults are much the same. We imitate and experiment with behaviors, attitudes and words. We feel overwhelmed with physical, mental and emotional sensations to the point of anxiety. We can feel overflowing joy, shame, humiliation, courage, fear, or even numbness. Often we don't have words for how we truly feel. As adults, we have the capacity to deeply listen and observe our own behaviors, words, and attitudes and potentially our capacities to be unconscious to the resemblance of how we are currently living our parents' attitudes, perceptions and behaviors, maybe even those of our ancestors.

Some aspects of our origins are so delightful that we want to keep them; i.e., family, cultural and societal traditions. Upon closer observation we may want to update other inherited patterns of interpreting life to be more in alignment with who we are now, and who we want to become. Other automatic patterns we may want to let go of altogether. Yet, we may notice that somehow they seem to stick.

When we insightfully observe and deeply listen to our own inner child, we can discover what we have been unavailable to see in ourselves: the behaviors, attitudes, beliefs, fears, doubts, and worries that we have copied from our parents, who imitated their parents and so on down through history. We can also discover the joys, creativity, dreams and wisdom of our ancestors that may have been forgotten and whose time it is to be revived. We can discover new enriching delights of our own lives.

We are each a major point of power, a point of potential dynamic change who can adjust

the destiny of ourselves and our heritage to bring in new possibilities of freedom, creativity, and outrageous shifts into higher consciousness.

Here is a meditation practice to discover your unconscious early intelligent beliefs that are outdated, but still influencing you. Have paper and pen nearby. Take a few deep breaths and relax into your heart space. Invite your inner children to meet you in a special safe and sacred place in your awareness. Be open minded beyond your expectations and past experiences. Affirm you are here for them, willing to learn their real needs, perspectives, wisdom and insights.

Possible questions to explore are: What behaviors and beliefs did you copy from mom and dad? What did you learn from them that you believe is still relevant? What do you notice is causing a lot of suffering? Encourage their honesty. Thank them for their commitments so long held. Acknowledge that you wish to help both of you to discern what is no longer pertinent. Ask, what did you really need as a child? Listen with a kind heart and give support to your younger selves. Discuss how you can be loving allies to access what is more truly aligned with



your highest intelligence now. Thank them and record all pearls of wisdom.

Adults often listen with expectation. This distorts perception and causes disconnection. Listen with the intent to be present, available and curious rather than judgmental to what's being revealed. This is key to creating safety and rapport with new revelations from your inner ages and stages.

Listen deeply to receive the intimacy of truth within you. You may notice a new resonance in your body as you commune with your younger ages and stages as they feel fully heard, felt and truly acknowledged. There is a new alignment, a profound healing, and a calming effect available to your nervous system. Scattered parts of Self come together. Breathe and feel this new sense of *you*. In the days to come, observe yourself from Presence and curiosity. Look for fresh new perspectives, possibilities and responses in your daily living to create potent positive change.



She has been in touch to say she is "sitting at the feet of the Master Teachers" somewhere in Heaven ~ forever learning about the Cosmos. Although she wrote this some years ago, the message is timely. We hope it inspires you.

She is known by many names, but her investment in humanity is huge and often unsung. She has been usurped by religions and relegated to the background or given status as *the vehicle of life*, but always shrouded in robes or in mystery. Yet, she is our Mother, the holy one who has birthed life and upholds us in her arms of Love.

Many years ago in the year 2000, I had evidence of a miracle that I did not fully understand. We all are participants in miracles, but often are so involved with seeing life through a narrow lens that we miss the miraculous elements that are around us all the time.

It was when my partner, Steve was undergoing a major health challenge (CLL Cancer Stage 4), and I didn't know if he would get well or not. One night I had a dream and in it I was standing outside a restaurant waiting for him to pay the bill. As I stood there, I could see the whole bay that ran the length of our peninsula, and hovering above and slowly moving down the center of the bay was a beautiful angel who was full of grace and shining her light as she went. I stood transfixed, as did the two other people who were standing with me, and suddenly as she reached the southern tip, she shot up into the sky and became one of a whole circle of images that represented the feminine face of God from all traditions. I was amazed and upon waking could remember this dream in detail, which was rare for me.

A few days after this dream, a friend called to tell me of a healer from the Philippines who was going to be in our area. He had a story related to Our Lady of Guadalupe, a rendering of Mother Mary, and she had told him to build a church on a particular spot for her. He had no idea how to do this since he was a truck driver and made very little money. She told him that she would provide the means, and that evening in his bedroom a flurry of rose petals fell from the ceiling, each with an image of a holy relic on them that seemed to have been engraved by a laser beam. He was astounded, but the message came that he should tell others about this and offer them as healing agents. People began to donate money to him, and soon the word was out about the Blessed Mother who was offering healing through rose petals.

When he came to our area, we went to hear him talk, and during his lecture, he asked for a huge vase of roses at the rear of the room to be brought to him. He said a prayer and stripped the petals from the roses and had them passed around to all of us. As



we took one and passed the rest to others in our row, I looked to see a plain petal in my hands. He then asked that we hold the petals to our chest and think of the Blessed Mother. After a special prayer, he asked us to look at our petals, and lo and behold there were images that appeared. I received an image of a Christ child. My partner, Steve got an image of the Virgin Mary holding her child. We were quite amazed. The next day we went with our friend to see relics that someone she knew had, and there was the image on a tapestry of Our Lady of Guadalupe. It was quite stunning, and we appreciated seeing it after hearing the story of the Filipino Healer.

A week later, my partner was picking up donated medical equipment for the non-profit agency he worked for, and while in the garage, the man donating it asked if he had any use for a box of decorative tiles that were no longer needed by him. It just so happened that our friend (Nancy) was producing artwork with pieces of tile, so he (Steve) took the box and brought it home. We didn't bother to see what the tiles were until a few weeks later. As we took them out, we saw that there seemed to be a pattern, so we laid them out on our picnic table, and lo and behold, there was Our Lady of Guadalupe! To say we were surprised is an understatement.

The synchronicity of the events that began with my dream were so stunning that I felt there was something of the miraculous connected to them. After that experience, my partner began getting well, and a diagnosis of only 4 years to live was soon changed to full remission. We put the box of tiles away, not wanting them to be used for art projects, and a couple years ago, I was prompted to bring them out and arrange them on a background so that we could hang the image of Guadalupe on our fence. We did that, and her presence has been felt ever since. I go out frequently and offer prayers and thanks, always remembering that miracles are real and around us all the time if we but pay attention.

Editors Note: This story took place about 21 years ago and we are happy to report that Steve is still cancer free. He is the co-publisher of *The Inner Voice*.





The Calm of Everything ~ as it should be

There is nothing quite like the calm of everything as it should be. It's something I'm more familiar with now that life is simpler, but still the calm never gets old.

The calm comes when the beds are made, dishes are washed, and the counters are clear. When space, exposed and bare, welcomes me home as if offering a place to lay down my anxiety, the unfinished tasks of the day, and all the ways I feel unproductive or small.

When the exterior of my life reflects the intentions of my internal life, only then am I able to escape the hustle of worthiness and allow the calm to change the atmosphere. I find myself whole, complete and content.

The calm of everything as it should be, as elusive as it may be at times, feels natural to my soul. It's a nurturing habitat that requires little beyond the few essentials for living, my loved ones close, and a great cup of coffee.

Trouble comes when things—like our possessions, busyness, or unexpected circumstances—throw the calm into disorder. When clutter creeps in under our distracted noses, a busy week turns into a season of hustle, or the unfortunate diagnosis or job loss disrupts the flow of life, the calm becomes an indulgent treat we crave rather than the standard by which we live.

Cultivating calm

Calm as a standard is pretty far-fetched, though. I mean, who do you know that describes their life as calm? And if they do, it's rarely positive. Calm implies boring, uninspired, attention severing. Let's be honest, we are in competition for people's attention. They've got email and push notifications blowing up their phones, birthday parties to attend, and committees to chair. Not many people have time for calm.

In a culture that celebrates busy, excess, and extroversion as the measure of a good

life, where is there space in our homes and lives for calm, quiet, and simple? For things to be as they should be? And what does should even mean? What is it that my things should be doing? I think the answer, at least in part, is in this quote by

William Morris, "Have nothing in your homes that you do not know to be useful or believe to be beautiful."

The things we own (or do) should be useful, having purpose in our regular way of life, or they should be beautiful, lifegiving external joys that reflect our internal peace and calm. It is the natural state of our souls, to be and surrounded by the useful and the beautiful.

To begin, it can be helpful to separate the useful and beautiful things from those that aren't. Here are four simple guidelines for achieving calm at home:

Everything has a home

Many things in our space contribute to stress, but just the right amount of the right things effect a calming atmosphere. By designating a specific place for each of our possessions, and diligently returning it when we are finished using it, our things require less energy and create less stress.

When everything has a home, we are more purposeful about what we own—if it doesn't have a home, maybe its purpose no longer serves us.

Everything has a purpose

Usefulness is essential to creating calm. Possessions that have outlived their usefulness contribute to stress, clutter, and decision fatigue—a condition where calm cannot survive. By owning only what we use, and eliminating what no longer serves us, we create a home free of excess and a mind free of regret.



Everything has a grace

The calm of purposeful ownership nurtures the condition of gratitude. We pour thanksgiving over the dishes that we serve food on, the blankets that keep us warm, and the car that gets us to work. We value doing things with our hands—like hand washing dishes or hanging laundry to dry—and choose to give away a bit more rather than keep just in case.

Everything has an end

Our things will not last forever. Their purpose will expire, their parts will break, and their meaningfulness will dull. It seems, the more we amass in our homes the less we appreciate the value of the lifespan of what we own.

This is particularly true with sentimental items. We overvalue the lifespan of the item and undervalue the emotional effect of holding on to it. The calm of things as they should be is often on the other side of letting go, because some of our things should be let go.

The calm of things as they should be is where our souls come alive. When we design an external life of calm by making beds or clearing counters or letting go, we awaken something deeper—the internal life of contentment.

I often saw her walking the property, circling the house, and I knew as she walked her path, she was nurturing me and protecting all of us from harm. One day, as I focused on

Elephant's love, I saw her circling the house, this time she was with her calf. The little one had her trunk wrapped around her mama's tail. This little one had complete trust that her mother would nurture her, take care of her, and keep her safe. I asked Elephant why she had brought her calf and what new message did she have for me?


She asked me to imagine that I was her calf. She wanted me to see that I could nurture myself in the same manner that she was

caring for her little one. Following her sage advice, I found it easier to have compassion for myself. I could become my own wise loving adult as I nurtured my inner child.
